Dear Parents,

I am writing to let you know that from **September 2024**, we would like to ensure that the children are all wearing our agreed uniform. Please see a list of exact requirements below (these haven't changed from what they were previously, but we would like all children to wear the required items (unless arranged with school for reasons personal to individual children.)

### Main School Uniform

- Yellow polo shirt (with or without the Whitley Chapel logo)
- Bottle green jumper or cardigan with or without the Whitley Chapel logo
- Grey/black: trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore
- Black or Grey socks or tights
- Plain black school shoes or trainers

In the summer a green & white or yellow & white gingham dress may be worn.

### PE kits

- Bottle green shorts
- Yellow, round neck t-shirt (no buttons or fastenings)
- Black, green or grey jogging bottoms
- Plain socks
- PE plimsolls
- Green drawstring P.E. bag (clearly named)

All uniform, PE kits, bags, coats, shoes and wellies should be clearly labelled with the child's name.

The wearing of jewellery is not allowed because of the possible danger to the wearer and to other pupils. This is a Northumberland County Council policy for reasons of safety.

The wearing of nail varnish is not allowed. Children are welcome to wear an analogue watch, but we cannot allow smart watches to be brought into school for safeguarding reasons.
